

Driver License / ID Document Requirements

US Permanent Residents

United States lawful permanent residents (LPRs), also known as 'green card' holders, are non-citizens who are lawfully authorized to live permanently within the United States.

You must bring specific forms of
Identification, Social Security and Residential Address

- US Permanent Resident Card (Green Card, Form I-551)
- Valid foreign passport **and** proof from United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), such as approved I-797 receipt, immigration judge's order, or stamp in passport showing that asylum or refugee status is granted/approved
- Immigrant Visa or I-551 stamp in valid passport

***Immigrants** with a name change must first update their name with USCIS **and** Social Security Administration (SSA). An original or certified copy of your marriage certificate or court order must be provided along with proof of name change with USCIS (such as I-797 for I-90). Please wait at least one business day after updating name with social security before applying for an updated license or ID card.*

Proofs of Florida Residential Address*

- Deed, mortgage statement, or lease agreement
- Utility, internet, phone bills
- Valid Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Medical bill or health card listing address
- Home or vehicle insurance bill
- Banking, credit card, or investment statements
- Mail from federal, state, county or city government agencies
- Mail from schools or colleges
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Letter from homeless shelter or transitional service provider verifying residence
- Postmarked personal mail (may not list the recipient as "occupant")
- Completed *Certification of Address* form

Social Security Number

must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Pay Stub with full Social Security Number

VETERANS

If you would like a veteran's designation on your license or ID, you must present proof of an honorable discharge such as VA card, Military Retired ID Card, DD-2 or DD-214.

100% Disabled VETERANS

Please bring your Disabled Veteran Card or Verification of Service Letter from the VA to waive fees.

Proof of Address Requirements

Applicants must still bring specific forms of **Identification & Social Security** as explained on the front of this flyer in addition to two proofs of residential address listed below.

CLP/CDL applicants must present two different proofs of address, either:

Two documents from List A

OR

One document from List A **and** one document from List B

*If unable to provide any acceptable documents from List A, applicant must provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with Clerk of Court **AND** one document from List B. Certification of Address Forms are not accepted.*

LIST A

Submit one or two documents in the applicant's name:

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater, dated within the last six months
- Current Florida voter registration card
- Unexpired Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- Current electricity or water bill
- Recent Cellular or landline telephone bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent Internet service provider bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

LIST B

Submit one document in the applicant's name:

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form, dated within last 6 months
- Recent bank statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent credit card statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent official government documents, dated within the last 60 days

- Current CLP/CDL holders requesting a renewal or replacement license with address changed from what is currently on file are subject to the same document requirements
- Current CLP/CDL holders requesting a CDL upgrade (example: Class B to Class A) are also subject to address requirements
- CLP/CDL applicants must present proof of residential address documents listing their own name
