



Driver License / ID Document Requirements

Non-Immigrants

Non-Immigrants (anyone who is not a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident) are entitled to a driver license or ID card for the period of time listed on their USCIS document(s), up to a maximum of four years.

You must bring specific forms of Identification, Social Security & Residential Address

Primary Identification original or certified copy

Photocopies

Valid identification and current USCIS immigration documents must be presented each time testing, identification card, or driver license issuance is requested. The listing below is not all inclusive; please bring all current immigration documents to your appointment for review and acceptance.

- Valid Employment Authorization Card (Form I-766)
- Expired employment authorization card **and** I-765 filed prior to employment card expiration
- Valid Canadian passport or original/certified Canadian birth certificate
- Valid foreign passport **and** Immigration Judge's Order or Notice of Hearing
- Valid foreign passport **and** current I-94
- Valid foreign passport **and** current USCIS documents authorizing Parole or Refugee status
- Valid foreign passport **and** pending application for Asylum

Non-immigrants with a name change must first update their name with USCIS and Social Security Administration (SSA). An original or certified copy of your marriage certificate or court order must be provided along with proof of name change with USCIS. Please wait at least one business day after updating name with social security before applying for an updated license or ID card.

Canadian Citizens will need to update their passport and present an original or certified copy of marriage certificate or court order to apply for name change on Florida DL/ID.

NOTE: License or ID card expiration date will be based on specific documents presented, not to exceed four (4) years. Non-US citizens applying for an original, renewal, or replacement license may be issued a 60-day paper temporary permit and receipt. Those applying for an ID card may only receive a receipt. Upon verification of legal status, FLHSMV will mail the driver license or ID card to the address on record within 60 days. You must wait to receive your card in the mail before applying for any additional licenses or ID cards. If a problem is detected, a denial of issuance letter will be mailed.

Social Security Number

must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Pay Stub with full Social Security Number

All persons who are eligible for social security number issuance/ authorized to work in the United States must provide proof of social security number (SSN) to be issued a license or identification (ID) card. If your application for social security number is pending, you must wait to obtain this prior to applying for a license or ID card.

Proofs of Florida Residential Address*

Electronic notices are accepted
Please bring printouts

- Deed, mortgage statement, or lease agreement
- Utility, internet, phone bills
- Valid Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Medical bill or health card listing address
- Home or vehicle insurance bill
- Banking, credit card, or investment statements
- Mail from federal, state, county or city government agencies
- Mail from schools or colleges
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Letter from homeless shelter or transitional service provider verifying residence
- Postmarked personal mail (may not list the recipient as "occupant")
- Completed *Certification of Address* form

CLP/CDL Applicants

Federal law requires all commercial license/permit applicants to declare their medical certification status and to provide a valid medical examiner's certificate (unless specifically exempt).

*CDL address requirements are different and can be found on the back of this page.



Commercial Driver License & Commercial Learner Permit Document Requirements

Applicants **must** still bring specific forms of **Identification, Social Security, and Medical Examiner's Certification** as explained on the front of this flyer in addition to two proofs of residential address listed below.

Proofs of Florida Residential Address

Electronic notices are accepted
Please bring printouts

CLP/CDL applicants must present two different proofs of address, either:

Two documents from List A

OR

One document from List A **and** one document from List B

*If unable to provide any acceptable documents from List A, applicant must provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with Clerk of Court **AND** one document from List B. Certification of Address Forms are not accepted.*

LIST A

Submit one or two documents in the applicant's name:

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater, dated within the last six months
- Current Florida voter registration card
- Unexpired Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- Current electricity or water bill
- Recent cellular or landline telephone bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent internet service provider bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

LIST B

Submit one document in the applicant's name:

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form, dated within last 6 months
- Recent bank statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent credit card statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent official government documents, dated within the last 60 days

- Current CLP/CDL holders requesting a renewal or replacement license with address changed from what is currently on file are subject to the same document requirements
- Current CLP/CDL holders requesting a CDL upgrade (Example: Class B to Class A) are also subject to address requirements
- CLP/CDL applicants must present proof of residential address documents listing their own name
