Federal law requires all commercial license/permit applicants to declare their medical certification status and to provide a valid medical examiner's certificate (unless specifically exempt).

Primary Identification original or certified copy

Choose one proof of Primary Identification from the other side of this flyer

US Permanent Residents with a name change must first update their name with USCIS **and** Social Security Administration (SSA). An original or certified copy of your marriage certificate or court order must be provided along with proof of name change with USCIS (such as I-797 or I-90). Please wait at least one business day after updating name with social security before applying for an updated license or ID card.

Social Security Number must contain full social security number

Proof of Florida Residency

- A current Florida Driver License or Florida Identification Card held for a period of more than six (6) consecutive months.
- A lease agreement, a current residential mortgage, or a a current residential deed, in the customer's name, signed more than six (6) months ago.
- A statement of domicile. (Declarations of Domicile are filed with the Lee Clerk of Courts – Official Records Department.)
- A homestead tax exemption on property in Florida. (Proof of homestead exemption can be located by searching for the property record on leepa.org and clicking the "Exemption Renewal Letter.")

Proofs of Florida Residential Address

CLP/CDL applicants must present two different proofs of address in their own name, either: two documents from List A **OR** one document from List A **and** one document from List B

LIST A

Submit one or two documents in the applicant's name:

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater in the name of the driver
- Current Florida voter registration card
- Unexpired Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Current homeowners or renters insurance policy or bill
- Current utility bill (water, gas, electricity, cable) dated within the last 30-days
- Recent cellular or landline telephone bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent internet service provider bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

LIST B

Submit one document in the applicant's name:

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form
- Recent bank statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent credit card statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent official government documents, dated within the last 60 days

If unable to provide any acceptable documents from List A, applicant must provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with Clerk of Court AND one document from List B. Certification of Address Forms are not accepted.

Current CPL/CDL holders requesting a renewal or replacement license, or those wanting an upgrade (ex: Class B to Class A) are subject to the same document and address requirements.



Driver License / ID Document Requirements

US Permanent Residents

United States lawful permanent residents (LPRs), also known as 'green card' holders, are non-citizens who are lawfully authorized to live permanently within the United States.

You must bring specific forms of Identification, Social Security and Residential Address

bring

Primary Identification NO Photocopies

- US Permanent Resident Card (Green Card, Form I-551)
- Valid foreign passport and proof from United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), such as approved I-485 or I-589 receipt, immigration judge's order, or stamp in passport showing that asylum or refugee status is granted/approved
- Immigrant Visa or I-551 stamp in valid passport

US Permanent Residents with a name change must first update their name with USCIS **and** Social Security Administration (SSA). An original or certified copy of your marriage certificate or court order must be provided along with proof of name change with USCIS (such as I-797 or I-90). Please wait at least one business day after updating name with social security before applying for an updated license or ID card.

NO Photocopies

Social Security Number must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Pay Stub with full Social Security Number

bring

Proofs of Florida Residential Address*

- Deed, mortgage statement, or lease agreement
- Selective Service card
- Valid Florida Vehicle/Vessel Registration or Title
- Utility bills dated within the last 30 days (ex: water, gas, electricity, telephone/cell, cable etc.)
- Financial statement dated within the last 30 days (ex: bank, credit card or investment account statements)
- Automobile payment booklet dated within the last 30 days
- Medical or health card and/or medical bill dated within the last 30 days
- Professional license issued by a U.S. government agency
- Employer documentation dated within the last 30 days (ex: paycheck stub, W-2 form)
- Automobile or Homeowner's Insurance policy or bill dated within the last 30 days
- Documents issued by Federal, State, County or City government agencies dated within last 30 days
- FDLE registration form completed by the local sheriff's office or Department of Corrections dated within the last 30 days

When using proofs of address in someone else's name, a completed Certification of Address form must be completed and the directions on the form must be followed.

VETERANS

If you would like a veteran's designation on your license or ID, you must present proof of discharge under conditions other than dishonorable, such as VA card, Military Retired ID Card, DD-2 or DD-214.

100% Disabled VETERANS

Please bring your Disabled Veteran Card or Verification of Service Letter from the VA to waive fees.
