Driver License / ID Document Requirements

Non-Immigrants

Non-Immigrants (anyone who is not a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident) are entitled to a driver license or ID card for one year, or until the specific expiration date on their USCIS document(s), whichever is sooner.

You must bring specific forms of Identification, Social Security & Residential Address

Primary Identification

Valid identification and current USCIS immigration documents must be presented each time testing, identification card, or driver license issuance is requested. The listing below is not all inclusive; please bring all current immigration documents to your appointment for review and acceptance.

- Valid Employment Authorization Card (Form I-766)
- Expired employment authorization card **and** I-765 filed prior to employment card expiration
- Valid Canadian passport
- Valid foreign passport **and** Immigration Judge's Order or Notice of Future Hearing
- Valid foreign passport and current I-94
- Valid foreign passport **and** current USCIS documents authorizing Parole or Refugee status
- Valid foreign passport **and** pending application for Asylum

Non-immigrants with a name change must first update their name with USCIS **and** Social Security Administration (SSA). An original or certified copy of your marriage certificate or court order must be provided along with proof of name change with USCIS. Please wait at least one business day after updating name with social security before applying for an updated license or ID card.

Canadian Citizens will need to update their passport or USCIS documents **AND** Canadian driver license (if one was issued) before the new name can be placed on the Florida credential.

NO Photocopies

NOTE: License or ID card expiration date will be based on specific documents presented, not to exceed one (1) year. Non-US citizens applying for an original, renewal, or replacement license may be issued a 60-day paper temporary permit and receipt. Those applying for an ID card may only receive a receipt. Upon verification of legal status, FLHSMV will mail the driver license or ID card to the address on record within 60 days. You must wait to receive your card in the mail before applying for any additional licenses or ID cards. If a problem is detected, a denial of issuance letter will be mailed.

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Social Security Number must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 or 1099 form
- Pay Stub with full Social Security Number

All persons who are eligible for social security number issuance/ authorized to work in the United States must provide proof of social security number (SSN) to be issued a license or identification (ID) card. If your application for social security number is pending, you must wait to obtain this prior to applying for a license or ID card.

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Proofs of Florida Residential Address*

- Deed, mortgage statement, property tax documents, or lease agreement
- Selective Service card
- Valid Florida Vehicle/Vessel Registration or Title
- Utility bills dated within the last 60 days (ex: water, gas, electricity, telephone/cell, cable etc.)
- Financial statement dated within the last 60 days (ex: bank, credit card or investment account statements)
- Automobile payment booklet dated within the last 60 days
- Medical or health card and/or medical bill dated within the last 60 days
- Professional license issued by a U.S. government agency
- Employer documentation dated within the last 60 days (ex: paycheck stub, W-2 form)
- Current Homeowner's and/or Automobile Insurance policy or bill
- Documents issued by Federal, State, County or City government agencies dated within last 60 days
- FDLE registration form completed by the local sheriff's office or Department of Corrections dated within the last 30 days

When using proofs of address in someone else's name, a completed Certification of Address form must be completed and the directions on the form must be followed.

Federal law requires all commercial license/permit applicants to declare their medical certification status and to provide a valid medical examiner's certificate (unless specifically exempt).

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Primary Identification original or certified copy

NO Photocopies

Choose one proof of Primary Identification from the other side of this flyer

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Canadian Citizens will need to update their passport or USCIS documents **AND** Canadian driver license (if one was issued) before the new name can be placed on the Florida credential.

NO Photocopies

Social Security Number must contain full social security number

Choose one proof of Social Security from the other side of this flyer.

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Proof of Florida Residency

- A current Florida Driver License or Florida Identification Card held for a period of more than six (6) consecutive months
- A lease agreement, a current residential mortgage, or a a current residential deed, in the customer's name, signed more than six (6) months ago
- A statement of domicile. (Declarations of Domicile are filed with the Lee Clerk of Courts – Official Records Department.)
- A homestead tax exemption on property in Florida. (Proof of homestead exemption can be located by searching for the property record on leepa.org and clicking the "Exemption Renewal Letter.")

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Proofs of Florida Residential Address

CLP/CDL applicants must present two different proofs of address in their own name, either: two documents from List A **OR** one document from List A **and** one document from List B

LIST A

Submit one or two documents in the applicant's name:

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater in the name of the driver
- Current Florida voter registration card
- Unexpired Florida vehicle/vessel registration or title
- Current homeowners or renters insurance policy or bill
- Current utility bill (water, gas, electricity, cable) dated within the last 60-days
- Recent cellular or landline telephone bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent internet service provider bill, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

LIST B

Submit one document in the applicant's name:

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form
- Recent bank statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent credit card statement, dated within the last 60 days
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub, dated within the last 60 days
- Recent official government documents, dated within the last 60 days

If unable to provide any acceptable documents from List A, applicant must provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with Clerk of Court AND one document from List B. Certification of Address Forms are not accepted.

Current CPL/CDL holders requesting a renewal or replacement license, or those wanting an upgrade (ex: Class B to Class A) are subject to the same document and address requirements.
